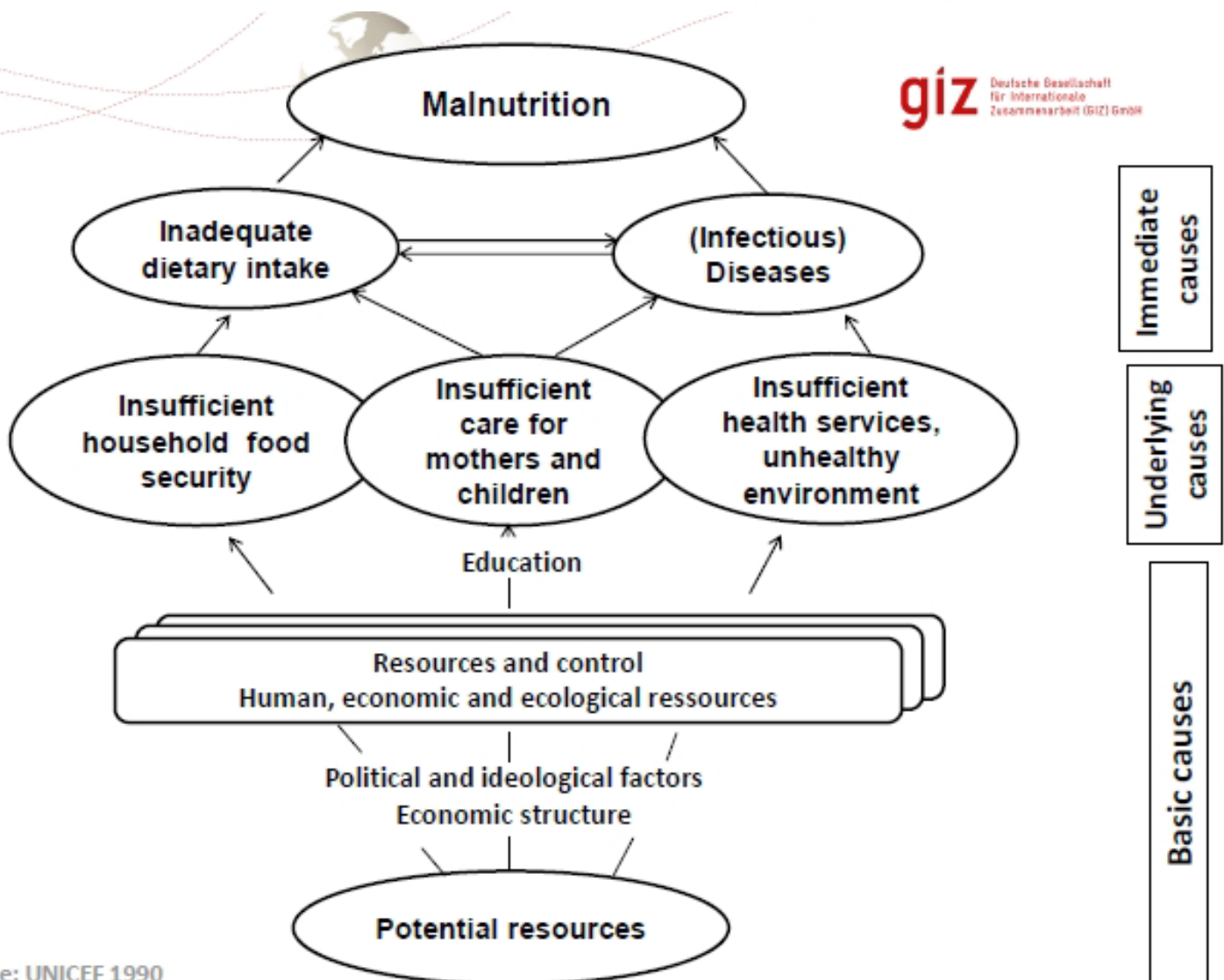

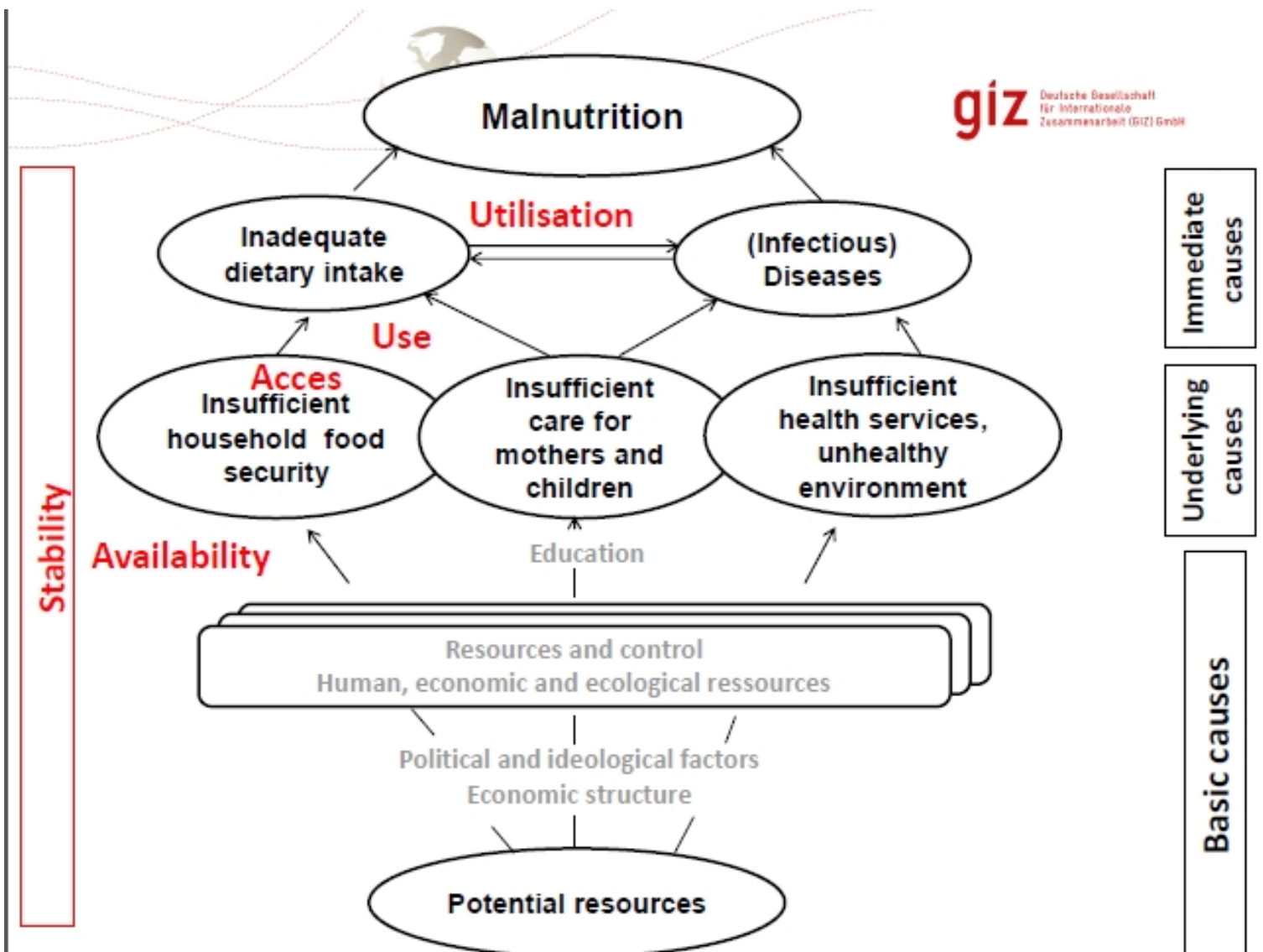

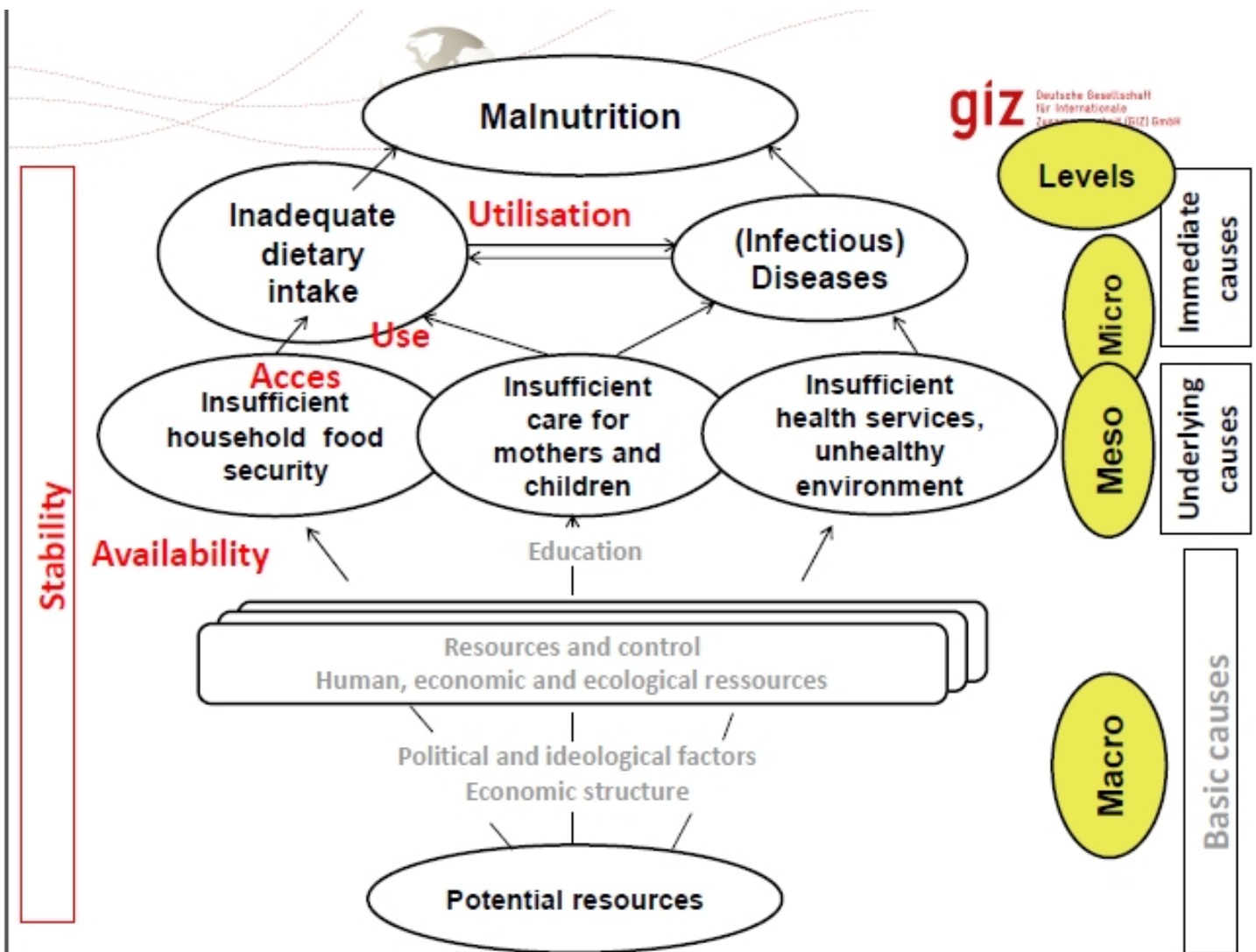


Link to the 4 dimensions of Food and Nutrition Security



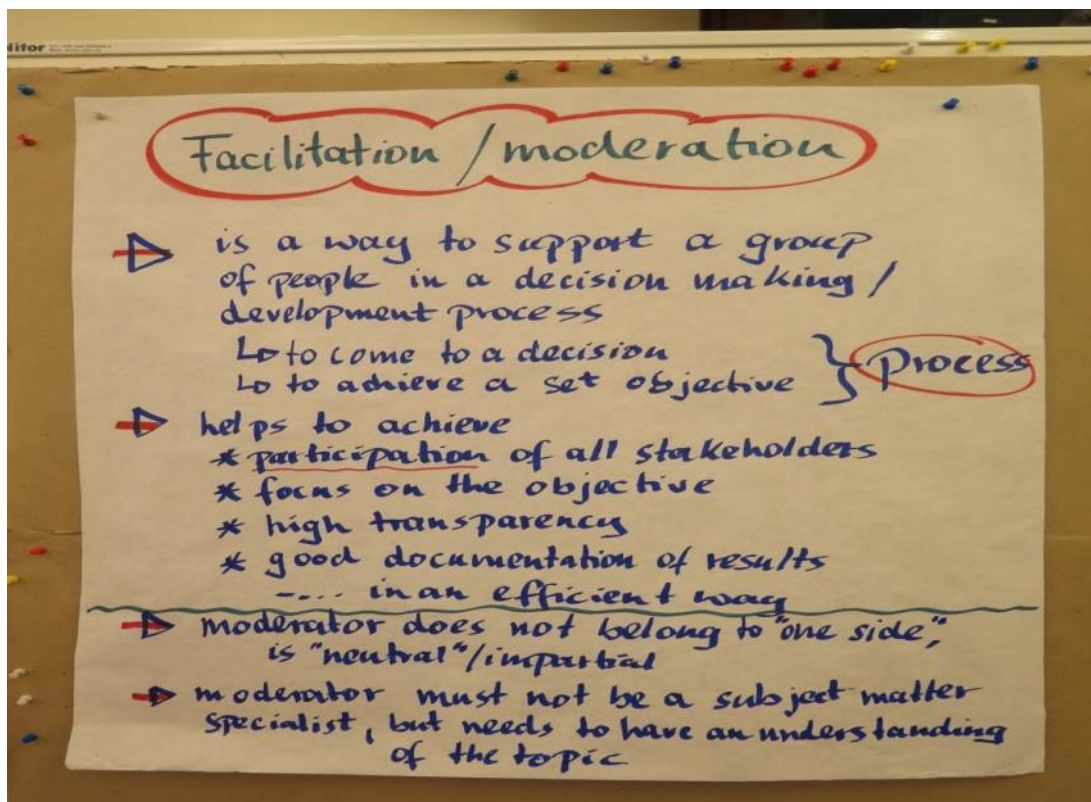


Link to the 3 levels of 'social organisation'



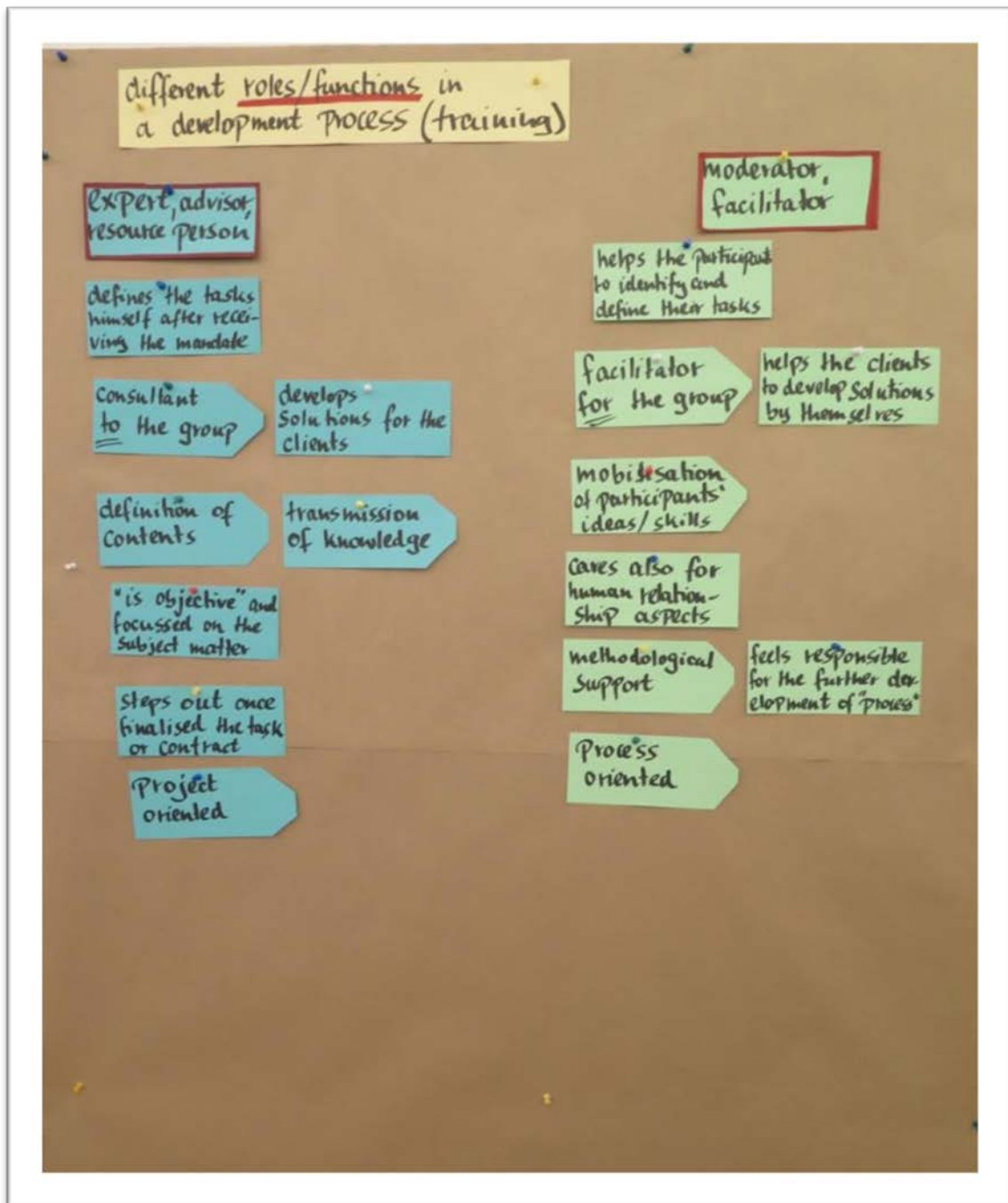

2.1. Target to the International Agreement 1990-2015

- 50% poverty reduction and food hunger.
- 8 indicators' agreement: poverty and hunger; education, gender, child fatality reduction, mother health, diseases, sustainable environment, International cooperation.



Millennium Development Goals (MDGs):

MDG 1: (1990-2015)

To halve the share of the population that suffers from extreme poverty and **hunger**

subtargets:

- To halve the share of those people that live from less than 1 US \$/day
- Full and productive employment and decent work for all, including women and young people
- Halve the proportion of people who suffer from hunger

Indicators: Prevalence of underweight children under-five years of age 1990: 25% 2012:15 %
Proportion of population below minimum level of dietary energy consumption 1990: 19% 2012:12 %
(undernourishment)
